KEEPING THE COMMUNITY INFORMED

In an effort to inform the community of the impact of COVID-19 on our district, we will begin sharing as much information as possible while also trying to protect the privacy of those affected. Please know that these efforts will be a work in progress and our district will make adjustments as well learn more during this pandemic. We share this information with you to keep well-informed.

1 - 5	PK-12 Active Cases	PK-12 Students/Staff who tested positive and currently in isolation. Numbers are presented in a rolling two week average and in range of five (5) to protect individual privacy. (Feb 1 - Feb 12)
1 - 5	PK - 12 Isolation /Quarantine	Students/Staff in isolation/quarantine due to positive test/close contact with a positive individual (5 day average) Numbers are presented in a range of five (5) to protect individual privacy. This number represents the week ending February 12.
0.60%	Isolation / Quarantine Rate	Students in isolation/quarantine due to positive tests/close contact with a positive individual as represented as a percentage of our total student population. This will be a five (5) day average.
5.4%	County Positivity Rate	This number can be very fluid, and the inclusion of this number on the dashboard is intended to represent a snapshot in time. NOTE: THIS NUMBER HAS CHANGED DUE TO STATE REPORTING. IT NOW REFLECTS A SEVEN DAY AVERAGE

In a smaller school district like Boyden-Hull, breaking down smaller groups such as building, grade levels or providing updates more frequently than once each week may make certain cases easily identifiable which may constitute a violation of FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act). It is the district's intent to update these numbers once each week and post this update to the District's webpage.
